Since 1961, **Michigan Paralyzed Veterans of America (MPVA)** has proudly served Michigan, making a difference in the lives of veterans, their families, and individuals with disabilities. Our mission is to enhance the quality of life of veterans with spinal cord injury or disease, as well as all citizens with disabilities, through advocacy, access to healthcare, and opportunities for recreation, education, and healthy living.

This July, our chapter has the honor of hosting the **45th National Veterans Wheelchair Games (NVWG) in Detroit** (July 9–14, 2026). For many of our veterans, participation is life-changing, promoting physical recovery, mental wellness, camaraderie, and a renewed sense of purpose.
